## What are the benefits of a peel?

Professional peels have a large number of benefits, some that can be noticed, and some that subtly occur under the surface of the skin.

- Reduced visible fine lines and wrinkles
- Fewer acne breakouts
- Diminished discoloration and a more even skin tone
- Increased cell turnover process
- Softer, smoother skin
